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Aquatic Nuisance Plant Control, Inc. hereby proposes an aquatic nuisance program which includes the following:

TREAT GALE LAKE IN 2017 USING CONTACT HERBICIDES. THE INITIAL TREATMENT WILL BE DONE (WEATHER PERMITTING) IN EARLY JUNE AT A COST OF \$3,550.00. LILY PAD TREATMENT WILL BE DONE IN AUGUST/SEPTEMBER AT A COST OF \$1,800. THE TMT WILL COVER APPROX: 9 ACRES

Covering the period of 5-1-18 through 9-1-22 Aquatic Nuisance Plant Control, Inc. hereinafter will be called the consultant.

GALE LAKE ASSOCIATION hereinafter will be called "THE representative of GALE LAKE. The consultant will furnish all labor, materials, and equipment for the following outlined management program to be conducted in the above said waters.

MATERIALS AND METHODS: All materials utilized by the consultant in this program shall be of the highest quality and used in the safest possible manner. All herbicides shall be registered for aquatic use with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and this state. Herbicide applications will be performed in strict compliance with the regulations set forth by this state and will be conducted under the direct supervision of a state certified commercial applicator.

PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION:

1. The application of herbicides shall be performed in a professional manner, using techniques and strategies which are most appropriate for the specific work involved. All work done, and materials used by the consultant shall comply with this agreement, or if this agreement is amended, shall comply with this agreement as amended.
2. The consultant will obtain and process all necessary permits from the appropriate state environmental and regulatory agencies.
3. The consultant will post the immediate treated shoreline and 100ft beyond the treatment shoreline (if permitted by the land owner) with posters on water use and all restrictions that apply.
4. The owner/representative, and/or consultant, jointly will be responsible for the notifying of all riparian users, within 100 ft of the treatment area(s), of corrective measures being undertaken and restrictions on water usage at least 7 days prior to the first treatment.

INSURANCE: Consultant carries workman's compensation, public liability and property damage. All will remain in full effect throughout the duration of the proposed program:

PAYMENT: GALE LAKE ASSOCIATION OR ATLAS TOWNSHIP will pay the sum of \$ SEE ABOVE to the consultant for the above outlined aquatic nuisance control program. Payment(s) shall be made according to the following schedule:


